My Famous Person


IMPORTANT: Your teacher MUST approve your person BEFORE you begin your research.

Report Requirements: A file folder will be provided to you.


Report Requirements. A file tolder will be provided to you.

Timeline	Find 5 significant events in your person's life. Organize them
	in chronological order (timeline). Use <i>detail</i> to describe these
	events.
Characteristics	Determine 4 adjectives that best describe your famous
	person. For each characteristic, describe why or what this
	person did to earn this adjective. <i>Use text evidence!</i>
Desktop Items	Infer what items your famous person might have kept in their
	pocket or on their desk. Print 5 images of items you infer and
	include a brief justification for each item.
Compare/Contrast	Include one paragraph comparing/contrasting your famous
	person to yourself. Be specific and focus on personality traits,
	hobbies, achievements, family, etc.
Cause/Effect	Every person experiences adversity. Use a cause/effect model
	to show what effect your person's challenges or adversities
	had on their life.

	recite this quote during the Famous Person Day Parade.








Desktop item pictures (5) with brief descriptions of why each one was chosen.
